2) <u>aims of this meeting</u>

- getting to know each other

- defining frames of activities

The activities in each country should not exceed 8 days, including travel days. Each partner will pay for their travel. Accommodation, food and activity fees will be provided by the hosting organization.

If the participants want to stay longer in the country, it will not be on the expense of the hosting organization.

The participants to the mobilities can be both dance experts and dance learners. Each organization will give the participants a certificate of participation to this Grundtvig activity. On each event, the hosting partner prepares a presence sheet to be signed by the participants.

The calendar of activities should be ready for January 15th 2011.

Latvian partner, initiator of this project has been refused by their National Agency. But we all decide that we invite them on our activities. They will pay their travel and *e*ach partner will provide food and accommodation.

- responsibility of each partner Every partner will prepare documents about their traditional dances.

Turkey :

creation and updating of website

get information about making tee-shirts (price ...) and flags with dancing figures on it.

Poland :

collect and gather all documents prepared by each group (written in English and national language) *for website / DVD*

France : make the final DVD

All partners will send Tufak suggestions for the design of the tee-shirts.

Our communication and organization emails will always be sent to all partners. The Latvian partner will be included on this list.

3) <u>aims of each event</u>

Each activity should be composed of three elements :

- dance and/or music workshops
- open public dancing party, with live musicians

- interaction / exchange with a local partner (school, leisure centre, old people, disabled....) This interaction with local partner will be organized by the hosting organization. Each partner has to prepare a small dance exchange activity for this meeting adapted to the public. This activity will take place for a half day.

Each event's programme will also include a day or half day of sight seeing / local discovery.

Each partner for each activity will provide the necessary material to make photos and videos. All this material will be sent to Citrus to make the final DVD.
